

Congress Must Restore the Clean Water Act

More than 800 organizations – representing the conservation community, family farmers, fishers, surfers, boaters, faith communities, environmental justice advocates, labor unions, and civic associations have called on Congress to clarify the Clean Water Act to reaffirm the historical scope of the 1972 Clean Water Act and ensure that the water bodies that today are in legal limbo because of two misguided Supreme Court decisions will again be covered by the Clean Water Act.
